## Congregation Opportunities

Workshop 1 – October 24

6:30 – 8:00 PM

Determine committee and ministry needs: This workshop will expand on the previous congregation and committee surveys: We will facilitate a workshop for the entire congregation that will list current committee, ministries uses, and elaborate future need. Issues to be discussed include number of people, activities, ministries and functional relationships. The discussion is documented on large sheets of paper.

Workshop 2 – November 7

6:30 – 8:00 PM

Determine space requirements: Facilitate a workshop for the entire congregation that will determine the type of spaces required to house the various committees, ministries and uses determined in workshop. Again, a discussion led by the Architect will get the participants to list out the various rooms and their required sizes.

Workshop 3 – November 21

6:30 – 8:00 PM

Design Solution: The Architect will engage the congregation in a workshop to generate solutions to the design problem. Utilizing the information from the first two workshops, we will lead the congregation in preparing graphic solutions.

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It was in Central France, and mainly along the Loire, that the systematic development of vaulted church architecture began. Naves covered with barrel-vaults, sometimes of pointed section, appear in a number of large churches built during the eleventh and twelfth centuries, with apsidal and transeptal chapels and aisles carried around the apse, as in Notre-Dame du Port at Clermont-Ferrand.
